## STEVEN CALLAHAN

### ASSOCIATE

Steven Callahan is an Associate in the Dallas office of McKool Smith. His practice involves complex commercial and intellectual property litigation. Prior to joining McKool Smith in 2005, Mr. Callahan was an associate with WilmerHale in Boston, Massachusetts.

#### REPRESENTATIVE MATTERS

**TGIP, Inc.** A member of the TGIP trial team, Mr. Callahan represented TGIP in its patent infringement lawsuit against AT&T involving pre-paid telephone card technology. TGIP obtained a jury verdict against AT&T following a two week trial in the Eastern District of Texas. The case settled favorably to TGIP while on appeal to the Federal Circuit. The other defendants in the case--Verizon, IDT, and InComm--settled with TGIP shortly before trial.

**Anascape, Ltd.** Mr. Callahan represented Anascape in its patent infringement lawsuit against Microsoft and Nintendo involving video game controller technology. After a two week trial in the Eastern District of Texas, Anascape obtained a jury verdict against Nintendo. As a member of the Anascape trial team, Mr. Callahan second chaired portions of the trial. Microsoft and Anascape reached a confidential settlement on the eve of trial.

**EDS.** Mr. Callahan has represented EDS in a number of arbitrations involving EDS' major contracts.

**Pilgrim's Pride Corporation.** Mr. Callahan currently represents Pilgrim's Pride in a lawsuit brought by the Kansas City Southern Railway Company alleging a multi-million dollar breach of an indemnity agreement.
