REPRESENTATIVE MATTERS

TIVO. *TiVo Inc. v. EchoStar Technologies Corporation.* Represented TiVo in a patent infringement suit involving DVR technology. After a two-week jury trial a verdict was handed down in favor of TiVo.

Intel Corporation. Mr. Chambers represented Intel in *Broadcom Corporation v. Intel Corporation*, a case involving numerous patents relating to memory arbitration, 3-D graphics and computer networking.

Electronic Data Systems Corp. Mr. Chambers has represented EDS in numerous cases, including *EDS v. Xerox*, a breach of contract case involving the then largest outsourcing contract in existence, and *DataTreasury v. EDS*, a patent case relating to electronic check processing.
